Scope and Content Note: The collection consists of documents pertaining primarily to the research conducted by Maurice J. Pollard into some extramarital affairs in his genealogy, namely his New Hampshire ancestors in the Moses and Emery families in the 18th and 19th centuries. The collection contains his typed "deposition" in which he describes his research and provides evidence for the ancestral irregularities. He also provides genealogical tables with the names of his notorious ancestors written in red. Four addenda provide biographical details.

Photographs of several family members are provided, as well as pictures of the family's homestead in Haverhill, Massachusetts.

Biographical background: Maurice Pollard was a genealogist, born in Haverhill, Massachusetts at midnight, May 11, 1892 and educated at Phillips Exeter Academy. He settled in Dover, N.H. and married Beatrice Theresa Higgins of Co. Sligo, Ireland, producing 6 children, five surviving. In 1961 he published volume I of "The History of the Pollard Family in America", followed by volume II in 1965. Pollard died in 1972.

Provenance: Sealed manuscripts donated by Maurice Pollard to the New Hampshire State Library on 02/17/1958, with the stipulation that the contents not be opened until his death. His heirs opened the documents in December of 1972.

Span Dates: 19th-20th centuries.

Collection Strengths: This is a small collection, of interest to members of the Pollard family in New Hampshire. It provides information not available in published Pollard genealogies.

Copyright Status and Access: The collection is owned by the New Hampshire State Library and may be viewed at the library upon request.
