

Scope and Content Note: The collection consists of block prints, photographs, correspondence, financial records, publicity, notes and writings, publications, studio items, and inventories of works by Herbert Ogden Waters (1903-1996), a New Hampshire artist who created wood and linoleum block prints, and watercolor paintings from the 1930's through the 1990's. He was an artist in the Federal Art Project of the Works Progress Administration (WPA) in the 1930s and 1940s.

Background: "Herbert Ogden Waters was born in Shantou (Swatow), China on November 15, 1903, the son of Baptist missionaries. He attended high school in Shanghai and then came to America where he graduated from Denison University in 1926. His post-graduate work includes study at the Pennsylvania Museum School of Industrial Art, the Art Institute of Chicago, and Harvard University. He received honorary doctorates in fine arts from Plymouth State College (1984) and Alderson-Broaddus College (1985). In 1932 he married Bertha Adams, a childhood friend from China.

"Since 1933, except for a brief period of war service in a Providence shipyard, Herbert and Bertha Waters made their home in New Hampshire. Waters lived in Warner, NH as an artist and art teacher from 1936 to 1941 in the Works Progress Administration's Federal Art Project. Later, he taught at the University of New Hampshire in Durham, at Holderness School in Plymouth, and at Alderson-Broaddus College in Philippi, West Virginia.

"Throughout a long career, Waters continued to refine his printmaking techniques, especially in wood engraving, and to explore the intimate and grand landscapes of New Hampshire from his home in Campton, NH. He completed his last engravings from 1992 to 1993. Various museums, including the Boston Museum of Fine Arts and the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the State of New Hampshire's Living Treasures Collection, as well as numerous private collectors, own examples of his work. The New Hampshire State Council on the Arts has collected some of his more recent prints through the <u>Percent for Art</u> <u>Program</u>."

Information in this section was obtained from a news release (see Box 1, Folder 10).

Provenance: The State of New Hampshire Department of Cultural Resources (including the NH State Council on the Arts, NH Artist Archives, NH Living Treasures, NH Dept. of Historical Resources, and the New Hampshire State Library) began discussion with Waters in the 1990's about donating his papers to the state. An inventory of his studio was done in 1995, a year before his death, and the papers and realia were donated to the state shortly thereafter, some with Waters' own explanatory notes attached. The Adams acorn press is on loan to the New Hampshire Institute of Art in Manchester. The block prints were acquired in 2002.

Span dates: The collection reflects Waters' professional life of more than 60 years, from the 1930's to 1996, with the majority of material dating from the 1980s through the mid 1990's. There a few family items from earlier in the 20th century and a few which post-date his death in 1996.

Collection strengths: Waters' own notes and commentaries, art studio items, as well as his active correspondence with fellow artists, gallery owners, students, and collectors provide a unique window into his artistic process and philosophy. There is an extensive range of photographs which document Herbert and Bertha, their home, their friends, Herbert's studio, and many of his artworks. The collection also includes 25 block prints, some located at the New Hampshire State Library, and some on loan to the NH Attorney General's office. These include 15 linoleum block prints:

Collection size: The collection is contained in 9 letter-sized Hollinger boxes (10.5×12.5 5"), 2 small photograph boxes ($5.75 \times 7.75 \times 5$ "), 5 flat oversize boxes (2 boxes @ $19 \times 25 \times 2.5$ "; 3 boxes @ $15 \times 22 \times 2$ "), 1 large storage box ($10 \times 12.5 \times 10$ "), and a basket ($13 \times 20 \times 12$ "). These require approximately 9 linear feet of shelf space, (assuming the small photograph boxes and flat boxes are stacked). The collection also includes an engraving table, a handmade wooden box, a bench, both stored at the New Hampshire State Library, and the Adams acorn press (on loan from NHSL to the NH Arts Institute in Manchester).

Copyright status: All materials are owned by the New Hampshire Division of Cultural Resources and are available for public viewing at the New Hampshire State Library in Concord, New Hampshire.

Arrangement and Description: In 1995, Terry Downes and Jan Wright compiled an inventory of the contents of Herbert Waters' studio and placed labels on many items. The materials were then stored in large archival boxes and put into storage; unfortunately many of the labels fell off and were lying loose in the boxes and the list they compiled did not readily correlate to the information on the labels. The inventory list has been included as part of the collection (Series IV, Box 11, Folder 83).

The collection is organized into series, sub-series, and folders. In most cases, description is at the folder level, except for studio realia, books, and artwork, where description is at the item level. Materials are placed in chronological or alphabetical order, depending upon the content.

Some items were deaccessioned, due to lack of adequate storage space and because the items in and of themselves did not add to the collection. These included two small saucepans, a floodlight, deer antler, dried leaves, and one of two hand mirrors.
